Cookie	Party Party	Purpose
IDE	Third party (Google DoubleClick)	Advertising exchange and performance tracking.
test_cookie	Third party (Google DoubleClick)	Ad tracking.
MUID	Third party (Microsoft)	Unique identifier for Microsoft tracking.
_ga*	First party (Google Analytics)	Identifies unique users for site analytics.
_gcl_au	First party (Google Analytics)	Tracks user interactions with the site.
_hFirstSeen	First party (Hotjar)	Identifies first-time sessions.
hjSession*	First party (Hotjar)	Maintains current session data.
hjSessionUser*	First party (Hotjar)	Assigns a unique user ID across sessions.
_uetvid	First party (Microsoft Bing Ads)	Enables remarketing and tracking.
ABTasty, ABTastySession	First party	Used for website experiments and A/B testing.
<mark>optimizelds</mark>	First party	Stores experiment IDs linked to the user.

Functional cookies

formStatus	First party	Tracks whether forms have been completed.

Targeting cookies

Used for delivering relevant advertising.
